### Call to Order 7:31 pm

**Welcome-** *Sandy Anderson- President, Opened and welcomed the membership*

### Principal Report:

- Heads up: SOL testing for 3<sup>rd</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> grade will be May 4<sup>th</sup> – May 21<sup>st</sup>. Week of makeups afterwards. Will be sending letters home for specific dates
- Update on renovation.
  - Ahead of schedule. Planning to be finished when the teachers come back in August.
  - Initially due to be finished with C&D by spring break, but now they will be done by mid-March.
  - Will give an update next week.
  - The school wants to give them some time to work on the new side, so now we will have to move one grade at a time to move to the different side. K-1<sup>st</sup> grade first. Then 2<sup>nd</sup>. And then may move 3<sup>rd</sup> in. Everyone may not be in the same spot they will be next year. Next year when the school is totally finished, some people might need to move to their permanent spot

- Dr Mackin went to look for furniture at different schools. Trying to see what the different furniture looks like. We are moving the old furniture first and then over the summer the new furniture will be delivered.
- Because of the bond that was voted on, we ended up getting quite a bit less than other schools. Newington forest got 150k more than us, Cherry Run got 200k more than us. We are trying to keep some of the old stuff and maybe we will be able to get new furniture to replace them in another year. Priority is classroom furniture.
- Meeting with the head of library services from the county and our construction manager and Mrs. Barham to look for library furniture.
- New library will be almost 2x or 3x the size of the current library. There will be a media room and it will be looking out to the courtyard.
- Every child is going to contribute a tile to the new library and 6<sup>th</sup> grade will have tiles in the hallway.
- Please be patient with us. We are trying to move as quickly as possible. We want to move in sooner.
- When are we moving?
  - We don't have an exact date yet, but it will definitely be prior to spring break. Somewhere in March.
  - Dr. Mackin will send a note out letting the teachers and the parents know.
  - They will be sending companies over to help the teachers pack.
- We are getting a new electronic sign.

- When we don't have access to the blacktop, we will get more field space.
- We don't have that much land, so they are going to give us an equal amount of space on the blacktop on the field.
- The only problem is that it gets wet and cold, but we will be looking at where it is less muddy, etc.
- Is there new turf incorporated into the playground?
  - No, it will just be mulch
  - \$18/sq foot on 18000 sq ft. It is not as cost effective.

### Officer Reports

  - Is everyone good with the PTO meeting schedule (only doing 3)?
    - Most in attendance nodded yes.
  - We believe we have successfully raised enough money to put the things in the playground that we wanted to put in.

  - We brought in 26k.
  - We have 19k in the savings account. We can move the rest when it comes time to use the money for renovations.
  - Current checking account 65k, 19k savings, \$225 cash account.
